e. 2010 Market Budget

McClurkan is in the preliminary stages of preparing the budget for 2010. She will consult with Kerr and Cutting, after which it will be brought to the committee for review.

B. Market Fund Raising

VanderBeek also suggested using a generic pledge form to allow donors to indicate their preference for their monies.
