ZONING ORDINANCE TEXT AMENDMENTS

ADOPTED: October 23, 2017

EFFECTIVE: November 6, 2017

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF TEXAS, KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN ORDAINS:

**SECTION 1**  
**AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 36 "CLEARZONING:**  
**ARTICLE 5 "Site Standards"**

Section 36-5.10, previous reorganized into other ordinance sections, is replaced with the following language:

36-5.10 UNDERGROUND UTILITIES

All new electrical, telephone, CAT-V, fiber, and similar distribution lines providing direct service must be installed underground beyond the main distribution line(s) if the development requires administrative review or review by the Planning Commission.

**SECTION 2**  
**SEVERABILITY**

Should any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, illegal or of no force and effect by a court of competent jurisdiction, then and in that event such portion thereof shall not be deemed to affect the validity of any other part or portion of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3**  
**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect eight (8) days following publication, after adoption. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
