\*While most Borgess facilities accept Medicaid, current regulations do not allow coverage for mass immunization clinics. Therefore, for our community-based flu clinics, we cannot accept patients with Medicaid, Healthy Michigan Plan, Cofinity NGS-Bronson Employees or any Medicaid HMO plans (e.g., Meridian, McLaren Health Plan, United Healthcare Community Plan, Priority Health and Coventry Cares). *Patients with Medicaid or Medicaid HMO coverage should call their primary care physician and schedule an appointment to have their flu immunization.*

## Borgess Community Flu Program 2016-2017

**Remember Your Shot and Forget the Flu!** The flu season is rapidly approaching and more than likely in the past you've suffered from the dreaded flu bug. Fortunately you don't have to let the flu virus make you miserable. You can fight off the flu with a fast and safe vaccination administered by our licensed nurses.

**Trivalent Fluzone Vaccine:** The standard flu vaccine. This is available for persons 6 month. of age and up. It protects against 3 strains of the flu virus.

**Quadrivalent Flu Vaccine:** Quadrivalent injectable is available for ages 6 months and up. The Quadrivalent vaccine offers an additional level of protection protecting against four strains of the flu virus instead of three.

**Pneumonia Vaccine:** Available for persons 65 years and older. Two additional groups that should receive this vaccine have been identified by the Centers for Disease Control: any adult between the ages of 19 and up who 1) smokes and 2) has asthma. The pneumonia vaccine will be available to patients needing their initial dose, at all of our clinics. Patients requesting a secondary or follow up vaccine will be referred to their Medical Provider for administering.

**Pricing Information:** Pricing remains the same for the 2016-2017 seasons. Both Flu and Pneumonia shots are covered by Medicare Part B. We accept all Medicare Part B Plans and most commercial insurances\*. We also accept cash, check, Master Card, VISA, and Discover as payment. We will provide a receipt for all payment made at time of service. **Please note that the fees reflect a discount for cash, check, or credit card payment at the time of service.**

- TRIVALENT STANDARD FLU VACCINE - **\$29** (ages 6 months and up)
- QUADRIVALENT FLU VACCINE - **\$38** (ages 6 months and up)
- PNEUMONIA VACCINE - **\$90** (19 years and up)

All above vaccines available while supplies last.

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
