<b>Fire Department Report:</b>	<p>Chief Tackett gave an overview of the monthly report and statistics for the months of March and April 2022.</p> <p>An update on the 360 Review was given to the PSC.</p> <p>Much discussion regarding the ordinance and the outdated language. The FD will make changes to switch over to IFC 2021 and the open burning/recreational burning pieces and submit the suggestions to the board for review and approval. The PSC will take the Operational items from the Ordinance (Article 6) and make suggestions for change.</p>
<b>Sheriff Department Report:</b>	Sandlin called Ives and said no rep would make the meeting. Thomas asked about the shots fired...but it was not in the stats. Julie stated that a gun was pulled at the car wash as well.
<b>EMS Report:</b>	No Representative - No Reports Submitted

-Dr. Kerschner stated that the CARES Data Overview was interesting. A witnessed arrest has a better outcome than an unwitnessed arrest. That is one of the reasons why we really need the ambulances here in our township and at the ready. What we can do as the PSC/Township,..AED programs, staffing, Prevention and Education to the community, Decrease our response times and ensure the education piece is here with maybe a BLS class at the township or the market.

We need to reach out to the higher ups in PrideCare and let them know our concerns. We need to receive the stats to at least see where we are and what we can do to alleviate some of our concerns. There is an understanding that we may not get better service with another ambulance company, however, we still need the data that PrideCare needs to provide per the contract. Karianne has requested stats from KIVVA. Karianne asked that we place PrideCare on notice and asked that we get the stats for 2022 by July 15th...Chief Tackett will call Becki Russon at PrideCare for the request.

**Public Safety - General:**

Dispatch data was submitted and shared in the packet.

Julie gave an overview on the direction (due west) of Treasure Island. The County Roads and Planning that they would like to change everyone's address on treasure island and the name of the road. They have old name roads such as kings highway, beach drive, etc. The county can mandate the changes, but Julie asked if we can just do some form of an aylias in the system to make sure it doesn't conflict with dispatching and it would save the homeowners from changing the address on their DL, Mortgages, wills/trusts, etc. Julie asked if the PSC had any suggestions? Much discussion took place, and it seems like an alias is the answer...it can be done and has been done in other areas.
