## Curbside Bulk Item Collection

**Pilot Program Begins April 18**

This Spring, Texas Township is partnering with College Hunks to pilot a curbside bulk item collection service. The township will be divided into four zones of ~1,500 homes per zone. Each zone will have one designated week for collection.

### Service Availability

This service will be available for single-family homes and condominiums located within the Township. It will not be available for vacant parcels, commercial or industrial buildings, apartments, or manufactured home communities.

### How it Works

Residents can place accepted items at the curb the Friday-Sunday prior to the start of collection in their zone. College Hunks will pick up the items during the designated collection period (within six days) and recycle or dispose of the items. Items must be placed at the curb by 11pm on the Sunday prior to collection beginning in that zone.

**Maximum collection per household is three cubic yards (approximately the size of a pickup truck bed).**

## Shred Day/Electronics Recycling Event



As a service to our residents, Texas Township will be hosting a combined Shred Day/Electronics Recycling Event for residents to dispose of sensitive documents and electronics in a safe and secure way.

### Shredding

A large shredding vehicle will be onsite to dispose of documents quickly. **Please note that there is a six standard file sized box limit.**

### Electronics Recycling

The Township has partnered with Comprenew to provide this recycling service. We'll be collecting items such as old monitors, TVs, computers, and various electronic devices. Some fees do apply for disposal of the following larger items CRT Monitors (\$10) and CRT TVs (\$20). **Please note fees can be paid by cash only.**

## Township Pursuing MDNR Trust Fund Grant

The Township has submitted an MDNR Trust Fund Grant application for the construction of a play area and pavilion at 6th Street Park. The maximum grant award is \$300,000 with a match from the Township. If awarded, this project would be the third phase of development in the park.
