## 7110 West Q Ave Facility Renovation Nearly Complete



In early 2024, the renovation of the 7110 West Q Ave facility began. This project included three primary components:

1. Demolition of the previous Township Offices to increase greenspace & expand parking for the Farmers' Market
2. Create a dedicated training facility for the Fire Department
3. Increase the operational space for the Fire Department, with additional offices and shared workspaces

The Fire Department is in the process of moving into the new space and a few punch list items remain to be completed. The Township also plans to solicit bids to repaint the exterior of the Fire Station (not included in the renovation scope), and to re-roof the facility.


## Passport Service Available By Appointment Only

On August 17th, the new Kalamazoo County Park - the Woollam Nature Preserve - will open to the public. Kalamazoo County will plan a "soft opening" for the remainder of the 2024 season, where the park will be open on weekends only from 9:00 AM to sunset. You will need a Kalamazoo County Parks pass (\$25 fee) to enter the site.

The Woollam Nature Preserve is located at the former Rota-Kiwan Boy Scout Camp, and encompasses 212 acres in Texas Township. This will be the seventh County park, featuring canoe and kayak rentals, fishing docks, walking trails, picnic shelters, and more. You can [view the Master Plan here](#).

The Crooked and Eagle Lakes Normal Lake Level project is underway with final equipment installation and start-up expected to be completed by early September. All pump station structures, piping and filter building are complete, including surface restoration.

Homeowners in the Crooked and Eagle Lakes Normal Lake Level Special Assessment District may see a decrease in their assessment amount based on the additional \$2.2M of State funding received for the project. Any potential rebates will be calculated after construction is completed.

## **6th Street Park Restroom Facility - Project Scope to Include New Pavilion**



Construction of the 6th Street Park restroom facility is almost complete and will be open before the end of the year! Because the construction bid came in less than anticipated, the Township Board approved the addition of a 30'x40' open air pavilion structure (included in the 6th Street Park Master Plan) to the project scope. Both components can be completed with a 5% increase to the overall project budget, which will reduce future

Be ready to vote in the August 6 Primary Election!


Michigan registered voters have several options when it comes to casting their ballots and making their votes count, thanks to the passage of Proposal 2022-2. This voter-passed legislation allows for nine days of early

**Absentee Ballots** are available 40 days before each election and can be mailed or issued directly at the Clerk's Office with valid photo ID. The office will also be open Saturday, August 3 from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM for absentee voting. Ballots must be returned by 8:00 PM on election day to the Clerk's Office in order to be counted, and may be returned via USPS Mail, using the 24-hour secure drop box at the flag plaza in the Township Hall parking lot, or at the Township Hall offices.

Want to vote absentee every election? Join the Permanent Ballot list by checking the box on your Absent Voter Ballot Application or online at [www.michigan.gov/vote](http://www.michigan.gov/vote). Be sure to keep your mailing address updated for future elections if you're traveling (especially if you spend the winter in warmer climates!)

Make sure your voter registration is up to date at the Michigan Voter Information Center at [www.michigan.gov/vote](http://www.michigan.gov/vote)! You can also preview your ballot, request an absentee ballot, and update your mailing address if you utilize a PO Box or will be traveling.

Interested in joining our Elections team as a poll worker? We're looking for Election Inspectors to work in the precincts on election day – elections would not be possible without the dedicated individuals who perform this important service! All Election Inspectors must attend mandatory training every two years to be certified, and the Township pays for both hours worked in the polls and training. ## **Township Investing in Maintenance and Expansion of Non-Motorized Trailways**

As part of the 2024 Capital Improvement Plan, the Township set aside funds for two projects to improve parking lots and non-motorized trailways and evaluate options for non-motorized trailway expansion.

### **Project #1: Improvements to Texas Drive Park Parking Lot & Phase I Trailway**

*Estimated Timeline: Work to begin after Labor Day*  
Scope of work will include crack filling, resealing & restriping the parking lot at Texas Drive Park with more extensive repaving at the middle entryway drive (near the Maple Hill Splash Pad) and to the driveway apron at the NE entrance to the park. Additionally, the Phase I Trailway

**Project #2: Trailway Feasibility Study**

Estimated Timeline: Fall/Winter 2024

The Township recently solicited an RFP for proposals to complete a feasibility study for the design and construction of the next phase(s) of non-motorized trailway. The intent of the Study is to identify and evaluate non-motorized route options between the destinations specified below, with public input as a key component of the evaluation process. Final recommendations in the Feasibility Study will be used to guide planning and development as the trail moves from concept to construction.

The Township Parks & Trails Committee and Township Board have prioritized four segments to focus on:

1. Texas Corners Downtown Development Authority (DDA) and 6th Street Park
2. Texas Corners Downtown Development Authority (DDA) to 12th Street via West Q Avenue
3. Segment A) 10th Street from Texas Drive to Q Avenue - including connectivity to existing trailway segment ending on Texas Drive across from Bentley Drive & Segment B) 10th Street from Q Avenue to Swallow Avenue
4. 12th Street from Queen Victoria Lane to Q Avenue

Township staff is in the process of reviewing the proposals received and we anticipate the project to begin in August or September. Please stay tuned for more information and upcoming public engagement opportunities!

## Summer Taxes Due September 16th

Your summer property tax bill is due in the Township Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, September 16th. Any payment placed in our Drop Box (located near the flag plaza) by 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, September 17th will be recognized as an on-time payment. Late payments will incur 1% interest each month.

### Payment Options

- Check (ACH) Payment - \$3 flat fee for each transaction up to \$10,000

Please bring the entire bill with your payment. We accept payments during normal business hours. For safety reasons, checks or credit cards are the preferred method of payment. There is a third party processing fee of 3% for all cards.

If you would like a receipt, please provide an email address or a self-addressed, stamped envelope. Any payment placed in the drop box by 8:00 a.m. the next morning will be recognized as an on-time payment.

Mail your payment to Texas Township Treasurer, 7227 W Q Ave, Kalamazoo, MI 49009. Please include your payment and the bottom portion of your tax statement. If you would like a receipt, please provide an email address or a self-addressed, stamped envelope. **Postmarks or check dates are not accepted as on-time payment.** In all late-payment disputes, the Texas Township Treasurer's Office will rely on the receipt stamp applied by Township administrative staff.

## Severe Weather Notifications

emergency tornado sirens in place, there are several mechanisms in place for residents to be notified of severe weather:

1. Purchase a National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Weather Radio monitor. These monitors stay silent until severe weather watches or warnings are issued for our area, then they alert with a tone and then voice messages.
2. Enable severe weather alerts on your mobile devices. Many weather apps such as Accuweather, provide severe weather alerts. One of the disadvantages of tornado sirens is that they frequently cannot be heard indoors, whereas many of us carry mobile devices both indoors and outdoors.

## Consumers Energy - Neighborhood Meeting


