## VI. Fee Clarification

Item 14. Mobile/Manufactured home unit site: When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee service, the number of park sites, and a final inspection. When setting a mobile/manufactured home in a park, a permit must include the application fee, and service inspection. These shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting HUD mobile/manufactured homes on a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service, and a final inspection.

VIII. Supplement to Electrical Permit Application

ELECTRICAL PERMIT APPLICATION SUPPLEMENTAL

If an onsite consultation is requested before a permit has been issued, a \$60 cost of services rendered fee will be charged and will be paid prior to consultation.

Plans must be submitted with an Application for Plan Examination, except as listed below. Plans are not required for the following:

- 1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 Amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area

Plans are required for all other building types and commercial projects and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that design professional's seal and signature.

IX. Instructions for Completing Application

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the permit for said work has been issued by the Texas Township Building Department. All installation shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. <p>Expiration of Permit: a permit remains valid if work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION.
