## TRAILWAY FEASIBILITY STUDY NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD

Texas Township is seeking public input on its Trailway Feasibility Study, which evaluates potential routes and impacts for expanding the Township's non-motorized trail network. The goal of the study is to explore ways to create safe, accessible pathways that could connect neighborhoods, parks, and community destinations within Texas Corners and to neighboring municipalities.

**Please Note:** *This study is for planning purposes only. No final decisions have been made, and no trail routes have been approved or funded at this time. Community feedback will help the Township evaluate options and determine if, where, and how future trail connections could be developed.*

The study focuses on expanding the Township's non-motorized network in four key areas:

- 6th Street Park to Downtown Texas Corners
- 10th Street: from Texas Drive to Q Avenue, then from Q Avenue to Swallow Avenue (including connection along Texas Drive from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to existing trailway stub across from Bentley Drive)
- 12th Street: from McLin Drive to Q Avenue
- Q Avenue: from Downtown Texas Corners to 12th Street

Community input is vital to this effort. We are seeking input and feedback from residents, businesses, and stakeholders to help shape trail priorities and design considerations. This engagement process and public comment period will continue through **August 1, 2025**.
